The West Hawaii Explorations Academy Public Charter School (WHEA) is a nationally recognized laboratory school with a science-focused, outdoor, hands-on curriculum. It features large-scale, long-term, projects that meet or exceed performance demands of traditional "standards based" education. The program works best for students seeking to challenge themselves in a self-directed, science-focused learning environment. The curriculum is writing intensive and college preparatory, but "Can-Do" attitude almost always outshines innate ability. While WHEA's pedagogy has been developed in the context of STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) education, it is actually designed to be transferable to nearly all academic subjects. The WHEA vision is to enable students to become productive and responsible practitioners of collaboration and stewardship, evolving into lifelong critical thinkers who are confident in their ability to solve complex, real-world problems. The school mission is to facilitate authentic learning through integrative, hands-on, self-selective projects related to real-world challenges. The position of Director is essential to the success of the students, faculty, and staff and serves as the chief officer of WHEA overseeing all operations of the school. The school seeks a leader who can inspire students, put excellence ahead of easy, and always remain student-centered. The Director will need to make decisions, conduct difficult conversations, and build highly collaborative teams, all while shaping a vibrant school culture.

The Director must be an instructional leader; teacher coach and evaluator who is able to create a culture, including systems and supports, that is built on the principles of restorative justice and motivates teachers and students to achieve their best and to work beyond their own expectations.

- At least five (5) years as a full-time high school or middle school classroom teacher
- At least three (3) years of significant experience as a school wide leader at a minimum at the rank of Assistant Director/Principal

- Demonstrated skill in communicating orally and in writing with diverse audiences, including parents, students, faculty, and the community as a whole
- Demonstrated knowledge of project-based learning and content integration across traditional academic disciplines
